





At Agence Française de Développement, we believe that every development project needs to consider its contribution to the fight against climate change. In Eurasia, thanks to our national and regional partners, as well as our network of country offices, we support innovative and effective projects that limit greenhouse gas emissions and help populations and ecosystems combat the negative consequences of climate change.

We ensure that each of them aligns with the Paris Agreement by supporting a lowcarbon and resilient development in the countries in which they are implemented.

MAINSTREAMING CLIMATE

As part of its 100% commitment to the Paris agreement, AFD ensures that each operation is compatible with low-carbon and resilient development. In addition, we have committed to reaching at least 75% of climate co-benefits within our overall project portfolio in Eurasia; this is made possible by including climate mitigation and adaptation into our projects, from design to implementation.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Identification phase

Firstly, we identify a viable project with one of our partners, and then we select the best financing tool to make it a reality. Climate-friendly projects are pinpointed in the early phase of identification. They must have a low-carbon footprint; in addition, our teams analyze their vulnerability to the impacts of climate change. In every sector, from transportation to water, sanitation, state reforms, energy, etc., mainstreaming climate is critical to successful and sustainable change.

Then, we commence a partner-to-partner dialogue, with the help of technical studies, to maximize the project in question's positive impacts on climate and decide together the actions that will be carried out to build mitigation or adaptation co-benefits. Both partners also ensures that the project does not drag the country where it is implemented into a high-carbon or maladapted trajectory.

Agreement and implementing phase

Once everything is settled, we sign financing agreements and launch the project. We provide support to our implementing partner, and we monitor the investment's impact on the environment.







Once the project is delivered, we collaborate with our partner in the initiation of in-depth evaluation to assess the project's contribution regarding climate.
